Options – You must complete ONE of the following activities to participate in our Summer Slide event in August.

1. I-Ready Summer Challenge – Use the I-Ready log to track the amount of time spent on I-Ready Reading and Math. The student must complete 2 hours a week or 18 hours total for the summer to successfully complete the “Summer Slide Challenge”. Bring back the signed log the first week of school.
2. Summer of Smart 50 Day Challenge – Students must complete enough activities to earn the amount of points needed for the grade they will be entering for the 2018-2019 school year. 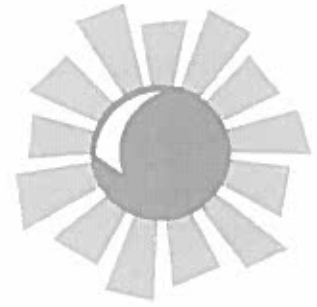
